Course Description

This 3 week A320 Jet Training Program is an introductory course designed for pilots who want to get hired as an A320 series First Officer, and gain proficiency in the operations of the Airbus Jet, to specific airline standards, prior to completing the airline's own FAA / ICAO Approved training program. All training is conducted to specific airline standards by instructors, who are highly experienced and current, Airbus airline pilots, with emphasis on positive reinforcement and achievement of results. Upon graduation, the crewmember is expected to fly the Airbus to airline standards. Using the A320 training platform, it provides you exceptional training in the following areas:

- "Glass Cockpit" / Electronic Flight Instrument Systems (EFIS)
- Flight Management System (FMS)
- A320 Aircraft Systems
- A318, A319, A321 Differences (when required)
- Multi-Crew Cooperation (MCC), and Crew Resource Management (CRM)

The Airbus-Direct™ A320 Jet Training Program consists of 2 phases:

Phase I: 80 hours of directly supervised self-study, utilizing computer-based-training (CBT), and a complete set of company provided training materials, including software, manuals, study guides, checklists, posters, and lesson plans.

Phase II: 40 hours (5 days) of Instruction, including Cockpit Procedures Training (CPT), 20 hours of Simulator flying in an Airbus A320 Advanced Jet Training Device, Pre/Post Flight Briefings, Qualification Check-ride, and Graduation Certificate award, done at the company's Advanced Flight Simulation Training Center.

The pilot candidate may undergo the following process:

- Eligibility pre-screening, conducted by CDA.
- Approval of Application by CDA.
- Issue of I-20 if required.
- Student Approval by TSA / SEVIS, if required.

Eligibility Requirements

- FAA / ICAO Commercial Pilot Certificate, Instrument Airplane, Multiengine Land, Ratings.
- FAA / ICAO First / Second Class Medical Certificate.
- US Citizen, or Resident Alien / Foreign National with appropriate INS / TSA Authorization.

Course Cost and Payment

- **Total Cost:** US\$5,995.00, payable by credit card, check, money order, or wire transfer.
- **Payment:** US\$2,000.00 deposit is required to secure class date, and receive study materials, with balance US\$3,995.00 due no later than three weeks before start of training.
